

Some form of the word "thank" is mentioned in the Bible over 130 times. The phrase "O give thanks" is written at least ten times. Thanksgiving to God is not a suggestion; it is a command - it is not supposed to be a 'holy' day, celebrated merely once a year. Thanksgiving is to be a prevalent attitude of the believer. True thankfulness will lead us up toward the 'courts of praise' and ultimately, into the presence of Jehovah. It is easy to gripe and grumble; it takes no real thought and focuses on the situation, the problem, the circumstance - everything and anything but God.

The word of God admonishes "In everything give thanks for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you" (1 Thes 5:18). When we thank God, we center on the One who is greater than every situation, problem and circumstance - who reminds us that "all things work together for the good of them who love the Lord, who are the called according to His purpose" (Romans 8:28).

All things aren't good, but all things will work out for "the" (God's) good. And, if we just trust that God has our best interest always at heart, that He doesn't set us up to fail, that He has called us to His rest of faith, that He intends for us to always triumph through Jesus, we will find that trials, sorrows, even pain, sickness and death are opportunities to thank God and draw even nearer to Him. So let us remember to practice true Thanksgiving, not just Thursday, November 24th, but every day.
