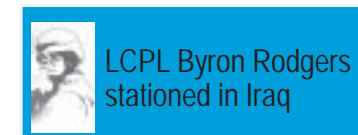

Travel Safety: To and from India as well as throughout the country. Pray for a special protection against religious antagonism that can occur without warning.

Health: Physical strength and spiritual wisdom and anointing in all circumstances.



Cultural Sensitivity: This is the first trip to India for Karla and Annette. The food and cultural differences can be a bit overwhelming at first!

Serving the Indian Ministry Teams and Communities: Strength to build relationships and fruitful ministry within Manna Ministries and surrounding Indian communities.

THE TEAM ANTICIPATES THE FOLLOWING ITINERARY:

- 7/21 – 7/23: Travel from Seattle to India.
7/24-8/1: Ministry at an orphanage and community preschool in West Bengal and Andhra Pradesh States and a new base in Nepal
8/2-8/14: Ministry at various locations in Andhra Pradesh and Orissa.
8/15-8/18: Ministering at a Pastor/Leadership Conference in Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh and in various locations in the states Andhra Pradesh and Orissa
8/22-8/26: Attend a Pastor/Leadership Conference in Port Blair, Andaman Islands. (Pastors frequently face persecution. *Andaman Islands are still recovering from the Tsunami/earthquakes major devastation with a predicted 10 year recovery of farming, fishing, housing, etc.)
8/2, 8/27, 8/30: Team will fly home (Karla, Annette, Linda, respectively)

INDIA: INSIGHTS INTO THIS EMERGING WORLD POWER

- India is the world's 12th largest and rapidly growing economy and is the second most populous country in the world.
- India borders: Pakistan, Bhutan, China, Nepal, Bangladesh, and Myanmar and battles high levels of poverty, illiteracy, malnutrition and environmental degradation, as well as subtle "caste" system and religious intolerance.
- There are 21 official languages (and 700 dialects) spoken in India with many more "unofficially" recognized and used.
- India's current government leaders are religiously diverse: Muslim President, Sikh Prime Minister and Christian Chairperson of UPA (similar to our congress)
- Religions: Hinduism 80%; Buddhism and Sikhism each 2%; and Christianity 3%.
